Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Are the camps open to the community?

Yes, the camps are open to all three and four year olds. Children must be potty-trained to attend camp.

Each camp will include a maximum of nine children so parents are encouraged to sign-up early to ensure your child's space.

Q: What are the camp times and costs?

Each camp, which will run from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. each day, costs \$50 a week.

Q: How do I enroll a camper?

Simply return the registration form with payment to Faith Christian Academy's Main Office or mail it to the school: Faith Christian Academy, P.O. Box 670, Hurt, VA 24563.

Q: Do I need to pack lunches and snacks?

Snacks and drinks will be provided. If your child has allergies, please bring a preferred snack.

Q: What is the dress code for summer camp?

Shorts, t-shirts and tennis shoes are great for summer camp.

Q: Do children have to attend every week?

No, parents can pick and choose the weeks that appeal to their children. They may attend every week if they like.

Cindy Jamerson will teach the first two camps and Katie Stevens will lead the last one. Mrs. Jamerson and Mrs. Stevens both teach preschool at Faith Christian Academy and have several years experience.
