Each camp, with the exception of aviation and chef's camps, are for students that have completed kindergarten through sixth grade. Learning Camps give children the chance to focus on an area that appeals to them.

Whether they prefer sports, art, cooking, aviation, history, or science experiments, campers will be able to expand their learning experience through a variety of fun activities.

## **Art Camp: June 14-18** **Instructor: Ruth Anne Adams**

Campers make paper mache' objects, a butterfly garden, dot art, use watercolors, and create art with the program Kid Pix. Students will also visit an art gallery.

## **Science Camp: June 21-25** **Instructor: Dustin Miller**

Campers will become scientists and discover how to discern between facts and theories with hands-on activities. Students will also visit the State Park.

## **History Camp: June 28-July 2** **Instructor: Dustin Miller**

Students will travel in time by "living in" in a different century each day, beginning with the 1600's. Camp will incorporate field trips, games, and reenactments.

## **Aviation Camp: July 12-16** **Instructor: Mr. Carter**

An instructor from Liberty University's School of Aviation will teach this camp. Children will learn aviation basics and take a trip to the airport.

## **Chef's Camp: July 19-23** **Instructor: Jordan Parker**

Spend a week making delicious sweets and meals. Campers will learn various culinary techniques, including baking, meal planning, and preparation.

## **Sports Camp: July 26-30** **Instructor: Dustin Miller**

Campers will have a great time learning skills in a variety of sports, including basketball, soccer, and volleyball. Students will also take a trip to Liberty's Snowflex.

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: Are the camps open to the community?**  
Yes, the camps are open to all children that have completed kindergarten through sixth grade, except for Aviation and Chef's Camps, which are for third through eighth graders.

**Q: What are the camp times and costs?**  
Each camp, which run from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day, costs \$85 a week and \$10 a week for before or after care, which is from 7-8 a.m. or 4-5 p.m.  
Field trips are included in the cost. Lunches may be brought each day.

**Q: How do I enroll a camper?**  
Simply return the registration form with payment to Faith Christian Academy's Main Office or mail it to the school: Faith Christian Academy, P.O. Box 670, Hurt, VA 24563. Enroll by the Friday prior to camp.

**Q: Do I need to pack lunches and snacks?**  
Children will need to bring a sack lunch each day along with a drink. Drinks may be purchased at camp (if you choose) for 60 cents. Snacks will be provided. If your child has allergies, please bring a preferred snack.

**Q: What is the dress code for summer camp?**  
Shorts, t-shirts and tennis shoes are great for summer camp. No pop culture or band logos on t-shirts. Girls need to wear one piece swimsuits or tankinis for swimming. Children should also bring sunscreen.

**Q: Do children have to attend every week?**  
No, parents can pick and choose the weeks that appeal to their children. They may attend every week if they like.  
By offering a wide range of camps, the school hopes to provide something of interest for every child.

**Q: Who is supervising the camp?**  
Each week is led by a different instructor who will focus on the specific learning activities for the week.
